Steven Ray Musgrove, 65, of Fairmont, passed away at his home surrounded by immediate family on Sunday, September 15, 2019, after a courageous battle with cancer. He was born August 22, 1954, in Bethesda, Maryland; a son of Samuel Ray Musgrove and Velda Amerilo Neel Musgrove, of Fairmont.

Steven graduated from East Fairmont High School and West Virginia University with a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering.
